QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION

The IRA Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) allows individuals age 70½ or older to make a charitable distribution annually to a qualified charity from a traditional IRA. The withdrawal amount may count toward your annual required minimum distribution (RMD). Although the RMD is not required until age 73, the QCD can be particularly beneficial for donors who do not itemize and instead file the standard deduction. Perry Christian church is a 501(c)(3) and a qualified charity for distributions.
